

Graduation Requirements and Grade Reporting through the Class of 2012

Twenty-four (24) Carnegie units of credit are required for graduation. Specific requirements include:

Class Rank Policy

The cumulative G.P.A. is calculated to the hundredth of a point. Students whose class rank rounds off to the same hundredth of a point will be considered tied and will receive the same class rank. The ranking will compare students within the same grade level at the same school. The class rank is not included on the student's official high school transcript, but is available for release upon written request.

Grading Scale

Student transcripts reflect weighted grades if the student took Honors or Advanced Placement courses. The numerical grading scale is as follows:
