### ***Colorado Department of Education Recognizes Chaille Cummings with Distinguished Award in Elementary Education***

She knows her students so much better in the online environment, giving her the ability to provide the children the instruction and interventions they need. These children are getting the best one on one instruction to meet their individual needs.
