OUR MISSION

OUR PROGRAM

Indiana Connections Academy includes a four-year comprehensive high school program with an enrollment of up to 7,000 students in grades K-12.

- Indiana Connections Academy is accredited by the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI), an accrediting division of Cognia, formerly AdvanceD.
- Indiana Connections Academy had over 125 certified/licensed professional staff. Of those, more than 25% have earned advanced degrees.
- School is in session 180 days between the months of August and June.
- Students can earn up to 12 credits during the school year.
- All students in grades 3-10 must take part in the Indiana Statewide Testing for Educational Progress-Plus (ILEARN or ISTEP+). Testing sessions and sites are available all around the state in the spring.
- All testing is mandated by the State of Indiana.
- INCA students attend monthly field trips and school events.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Indiana Connections Academy operates on a semester system utilizing 1 credit per course per semester. Students who have taken high school level courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The Typical course load is six credits per semester.
