

Graduation Pathway Procedures

For the Class of 2023 and Beyond, students must complete the following THREE Requirements

Requirement 1: Course Completion (20 Total Credits)

Requirement 2: Demonstrating Competency

GRCA students are expected to earn a competency score on the ELA II and ALG 1 EOC (or Basic scores for Math and English if participating in Alternate Assessments) <u>OR</u> demonstrate competency on one of the 4 alternate pathways:

ELA II (Score of 684 or higher)	College Credit Plus	Career Experience
Algebra 1 (Score of 684 or higher)	☐ ACT/SAT	Earn a cumulative score of Proficient or higher on 3 WebXams in a career pathway

If a student is unable to pass the EOC or AASCD after multiple attempts with remediation in between and is unable to meet one of the 5 alternate pathways, meet with the IEP team including Special Education Leadership to discuss excusal from competency requirements for state tests.

Requirement 3: Demonstrating Readiness (Seals)

GRCA students are expected to earn at least 2 seals, 1 of which must be state defined:
