| Ashland University               | <a href="#">15- and 30-hour pathways</a>                 | <p>Any 30-hour pathway would be equivalent to one year of college coursework. CCP students are not limited to the 15- and 30-hour pathways that we created above. They can find degree requirements for any major at AU and make their own personalized pathway. We guide new students on how to find this information in their orientation module (<a href="http://ashland.edu/ccp-orientation">ashland.edu/ccp-orientation</a>).</p> <p>We recently created the CCP Business Academy, where students can work on the core requirements of a BS in Business Administration degree as a CCP student. This academy provides an additional \$1000 scholarship beyond the usual \$4000 scholarship provided to all of our CCP students. Details are listed <a href="#">HERE</a>. These courses are available completely online.</p> <p>We also have the new <a href="#">CCP Nursing Academy</a> where students can complete 36 hours toward the BS in Nursing (BSN). By doing so, they will be on track to complete the degree in 3 years after high school. All but three of these courses can be completed online.</p> <p>Students may opt for an <a href="#">associate degree</a>. With the Associate of Arts in General Studies, students complete 36 hours in core requirements. There are concentrations available in <a href="#">business, art, and criminal justice, etc.</a></p> |
