ADVANCED COURSE OPTIONS

Oklahoma Connections Academy's core curriculum is geared toward preparing students for college and beyond. Students have access to AP, Honors, and College Preparatory courses. Students also have the opportunity to participate in the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) program, in which they can earn dual high school and college credit by attending post-secondary institutions.

AP course offerings include: Biology, Calculus AB, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Environmental Science, Human Geography, U.S. Government, and U.S. History.

Honors course offerings include: Algebra I and II, American Government, Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, English 9-12, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, U.S. History, and World History.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS


Oklahoma Connections Academy operates on a semester system utilizing Carnegie units. One semester class equals one-half of a high school credit. Students who have taken high school level courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The typical course load is six classes per semester.
