## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

ORCAP uses a standard whereby one credit equals approximately 180 hours of instruction, referred to as Carnegie Units. Students are required to be enrolled in a minimum of six courses per semester in grades K-11 and four courses in grade 12 in order to be considered full-time students.

### STATE AND NATIONAL TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Oregon Connections Academy adheres to all state and national testing requirements, and additionally encourages students to take the appropriate college entrance and preparatory exams necessary for reaching their personal and academic goals.

## GRADE SCALE

Oregon Connections Academy students are awarded credit for courses in which they have earned a grade of D- (60%) or higher. This applies both to courses taken at ORCA and at other schools. Courses required for graduation must be re-taken by the student if a grade of D- (60%) is not earned and re-taking such courses may delay the student's graduation.
