COLLEGE AND CAREER PREPARATION

LCCA offers lessons to all students, K-12, in career exploration. Beginning in 8th grade, students and counselors meet to discuss the student's Individual Graduation Plan, where students explore careers and post-secondary options. High School students are invited to attend college visits. LCCA offers middle and high school students lesson that explore college admissions and scholarships. Students will be invited, by grade level, to attend field trips that include career exploration within South Carolina's vast industrial partners.

GRADE SCALE
