Graduation Rate

Our first cohort of students graduate in the 2021-22 school year at Tennessee Connections Academy Johnson County 9-12 School. The official state graduation rate has not been released yet, but our internal reports are reflecting a rate of 91%.

Post-Graduation Plans

- 50% of 2021-2022 TNCA Graduates plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college.
- 13% of 2021-2022 TNCA Graduates plan to attend a technical or other school.
- 3.7% of 2021-2022 TNCA Graduates plan to take a gap year and/or travel.
- 9.3% of 2021-2022 TNCA Graduates plan to join the workforce immediately.

Special Accomplishments for 2021-22

- TNCAJ was accredited by SACS CASI, an accrediting division of Cognia!
- Staff survey results for fall and spring at 91% and 86% positive engagement
- We tested in 27 locations across the state for TCAP and EOC with a participation of 90% for grades 2-8 TCAP and upwards of 95% for almost EOCs.
- The average ACT composite score increased by 2 points.

"What's Next"

During the 2022-23 school year, TNCA will focus on the following area:

- We will continue to strive for pass rates above 90% in English, science and social studies, and math.
- We are committed to meeting or exceeding our double AMO on the state achievement tests in the spring.
- We aim to increase the average ACT composite score by 2 points by utilizing ACT prep webinars in partnership with UT Martin.
- Obtain 95% participation rate for TCAP grades 2-8 and EOC grades 9-12.
- We will continue to support all high school students in graduating on-time, in 4-years and significantly improve our graduation rate.
- We will reduce our chronic absenteeism rate by 50%
