#### **Graduation Rate**

For the Graduation Class of 2023-2024 at Tennessee Connections Academy Johnson County 9-12 school, the official state graduation rate has not yet been released. Our internal calculations estimate a 92% graduation rate. The TN State School Report Card currently reports an overall graduation rate of 90.0% for the 2021-2022 graduating class.

  - 84 TNCA Early Graduates (December)
  - o 290 TNCA Spring Graduates

#### Post-Graduation Plans

- 30% of 2023-2024 TNCA Graduates plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college.
- 10% of 2023-2024 TNCA Graduates plan to attend a technical or other school.
- 5% 2023-2024 TNCA Graduates plan to take a gap year and/or travel.
- 1% of 2023-2024 TNCA Graduates plan to join the workforce immediately.
- 5 students 2023-2024 TNCA Graduates plan to join the military.

#### Special Accomplishments for 2023-24

- We rolled out our TCAT partnerships and two senior students to successfully enroll and complete TCAT courses.
- We had over 50 students participate in Dual Enrollment opportunities with one of our three partners.
- 1 million in scholarship amounts with one student graduating with almost \$100,000 in scholarship dollars.
- TNCA is among the largest schools in the state of TN. TNCA Students represent every county in the state except for 1. We have 120 employees supporting over 2,800 students across 432 miles.
- 85% of parents are "Satisfied" with their children's education at TNCA! (parent satisfaction survey).
- TNCA has partnered with Coursera to offer students certificate programs that will make them
  more college and career-ready, with more course offerings. We have also adopted CTE courses
  for our middle school students to expand their understanding of available career paths they
  might pursue.
- A TNCA teacher was awarded a grant to attend the National Alliance of Black School Educators conference in December.
- TNCA has a thriving, competitive E-Sports team, and had 3 teams make it to the state final

competition, including 1 team to the Sweet 16.

- The continued development of multiple, specialized programs to support students, such as our Student Support Intervention and Probation (SSIP) program.
- State accountability achievements include:
  - 96%+ (up to 100% in some sub-groups, Biology EOC, and grade 5 TCAP) state testing participation rate.
