Utah Connections Academy includes a four-year comprehensive high school program with an enrollment of 950 students. Here are some important facts about the program:

- School is in session 180 days between the months of August and June.
- High school students can typically earn up to 6 credits during the school year.

## STUDENT POPULATION

Utah Connections Academy is an accredited, public school serving students in grades K-12 from across the state. Our students come from urban, suburban, and rural communities. The school was founded during the 2011-12 school year as a K-12 school. The school's first 12th grade class graduated in June 2012. There were 91 graduates in 2026.

## ADVANCED COURSE OPTIONS

Utah Connections Academy's core curriculum is geared toward preparing students for college and beyond. Students have access to AP, Honors, College Preparatory, and Basic programs. In addition, UCA offers Gifted and Talented opportunities to elementary students who qualify.

Our staff is trained in providing rigor and opportunity to students who excel. Students also can participate in the Concurrent Enrollment (CE) program, in which they can earn concurrent high school and college credit by attending post-secondary institutions.

**Advanced Placement (AP) course offerings:** English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Calculus AB, Computer Science Principles, Biology, US History, US Government.

**Honors course offerings:** English 9-12, Precalculus, Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, American Government, US History, and World History.

**Concurrent Enrollment:** UCA has contracts with 3 four-year colleges and 1 two-year college.

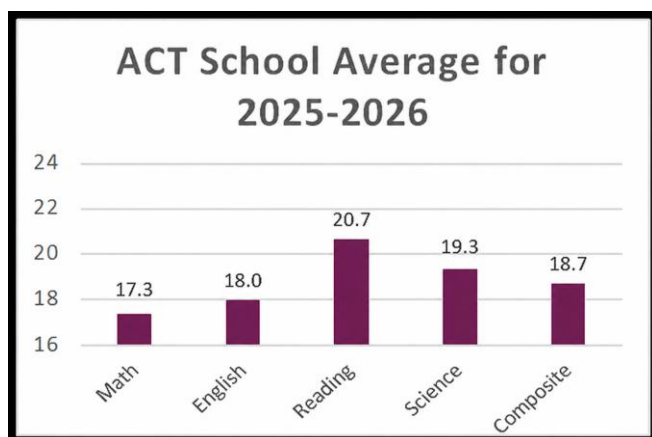
