PROGRAM SPECIFICS

Our leadership council works with the student's district to:

- ✓ complete a transcript review and plan an appropriate course of study (Grades 1-12).
- ✓ participate in all state testing requirements.
- ✓ prepare for college entrance exams, AP testing, and graduation.
- ✓ provide accountability for attendance mandates.
- ✓ review student progress of mastery towards Common Core Standards/ National Standards.
- ✓ comply with accommodations stated in a students' IEP/504, although individual services remain in the district.

SPECIAL POPULATIONS

Students who receive Special Education services will continue to have services provided by their resident school district. Rhode Island Connections Academy will provide our standard education program in accordance with any IEP, or 504 plan shared by the school district, setting forth necessary Accommodations and Modifications in the general education setting to support students.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students' course loads and schedules are determined by the students' resident districts and reviewed with the RhoCA counseling staff. Typically, students must successfully complete at least 20 credits to receive a Rhode Island high school diploma. Students receive their diplomas and graduate from their resident district. Districts are responsible for working with RhoCA in ensuring students meet graduation requirements. District staff work cooperatively with our counseling services to regularly perform credit audits to ensure students are on track to graduate and meet the appropriate district and state requirements.

ADVANCED COURSE OPTIONS

Rhode Island Connections Academy's core curriculum is geared toward preparing students for college and beyond. Students have access to Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, and College Preparatory classes. Pearson Virtual Schools supplements RhoCA with Honors and AP classes.

Advanced Placement (AP) course offerings:

AP English Literature & Composition, AP Language and Composition, AP Calculus AB, AP Statistics, AP Biology, AP Microeconomics, AP United States Government and Politics, AP United States History, AP Computer Science A.
