The mission of Alabama Connections Academy is to partner with students and families, focusing on individual student success in a flexible learning environment.

OUR HISTORY

Alabama Connections Academy (ALCA) began providing virtual, public education to students across Alabama in August 2017. Located in Athens, AL, ALCA serves students in kindergarten through 12th grade. The school is recognized by the Alabama State Department of Education as a Limestone County School District public school. Alabama Connections Academy is accredited by the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement, the Northwest Accreditation Commission, and the Southern Association of Colleges & Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI), which are accrediting divisions of Cognia.

OUR PROGRAM

At Alabama Connections Academy, we believe *All Learners Can Achieve* and our program blends academic rigor with the flexibility for students to pursue athletics, arts, internships, research, and work without sacrificing educational quality.

Serving approximately 7,600 students in grades K-12, ALCA delivers a standards-aligned curriculum through a mix of live and independent instruction. Elementary and middle school students take yearlong courses with semester grading. High school students follow a block schedule, typically completing four courses each semester for up to eight credits annually (1.0 credit = 140 instructional hours).

Our college-preparatory program includes 13 Advanced Placement courses, 17 Honors courses, dual enrollment opportunities, and career technical education pathways. All graduates meet Alabama State Department of Education diploma requirements, equipped with the skills and knowledge for success in college, career, or military service.

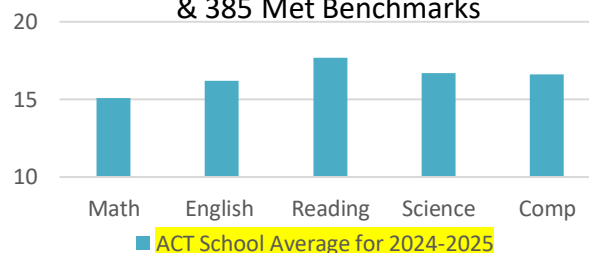
