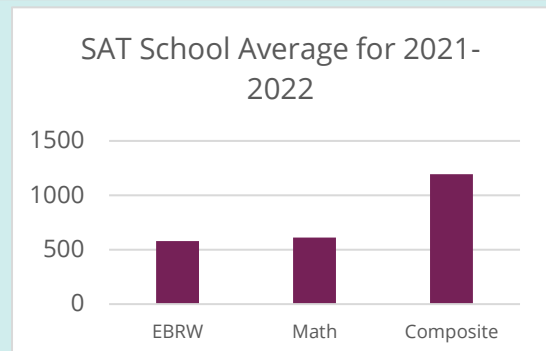
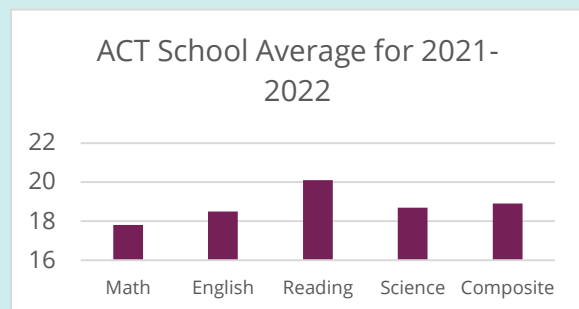
GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Arizona Connections Academy operates on a semester system utilizing Carnegie units. One semester class equal one-half of a high school credit. Students who have taken high school level courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The typical course load is six classes per semester.
