GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Coastal Connections Academy operates on a semester system. One semester class equals one-half (0.5) of a high school credit. Students who have taken high school courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The typical course load is six classes per semester. 24 credits are required for graduation. Specific requirements include:
