- All testing is mandated by the State of Indiana.

ADVANCED COURSE OPTIONS

Advanced Placement courses include: English, Math and Biology. **Dual Credit courses include:** English, Math, Social Sciences, Business and Social Studies.

AP AND DUAL ENROLLMENT

- 29 Students took an AP course, 32 total exams taken
- 55.3% of AP exams were passed with a score of a 3, 4, or 5.
