OUR PROGRAM

Kansas Connections Academy is a full-time, tuition-free, online public-school serving students in grades Kindergarten through 12th grade. Accredited by the Kansas State Department of Education and authorized through Elkhart Unified School District 218, the school provides families across Kansas with a high-quality, flexible education that blends state academic standards with innovative online learning. With an enrollment of approximately 1,300 students representing nearly every county in Kansas, our school supports a diverse community of learners with a wide range of strengths and aspirations.

COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS

- Kansas Connections Academy includes a four-year comprehensive high school program with an enrollment of around 700 high school students. Post-graduation plans for the class of 2025 include: 2-year college (23%), 4-year college (24%), vocational training (20%), employment (23%), and military (3%).
- Students can earn up to eight credits during the school year.
- Many KCA high school students earn college credit each year through dual enrollment partnerships with Kansas community and technical colleges.
- Kansas Connections Academy students complete all state-required assessments and are provided guidance and opportunities to take college entrance and preparatory exams that align with individual academic and career goals.
- All graduates meet Kansas State Department of Education diploma requirements, equipped with the skills and knowledge for success in college, career, or military service.

Honors course offerings include: Algebra I and II, American Government, Biology, Chemistry, English 9-12, Geometry, Precalculus, U.S. History, and World History.

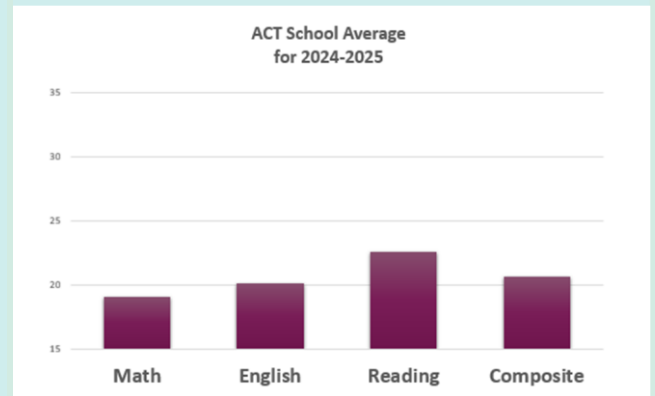
In 2024-2025 KCA had approx. 6% of 11th and 12th grade students participate in AP or Dual Credit Enrollment courses.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Kansas Connections Academy operates on a semester system using Carnegie units. One semester class equals one half of a high school credit. Students who have taken high school classes in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The typical course load is six or seven courses per semester.
