GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Pennwood Cyber Charter School operates on a semester system utilizing Carnegie units. One semester class equals one-half of a high school credit and one credit equals approximately 180 hours of instruction.

STATE AND NATIONAL TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Pennwood Cyber Charter School adheres to all state and national testing requirements, and additionally encourages students to take the appropriate college entrance and preparatory exams necessary for reaching their personal and academic goals.

GRADE SCALE

Pennwood Cyber Charter School students are awarded credit for courses in which they have earned a grade of D- (60%) or higher. This applies both to courses taken at Pennwood and at other schools. Courses required for graduation must be re-taken by the student if a grade of D- (60%) is not earned and re-taking such courses may delay the student's graduation.
