Pennwood Cyber Charter School is a K-12 school with a comprehensive high school program entering its second year. Here are some important facts about the program:

- Pennwood's school year runs August to June (195 days) and includes a 3-week Connections Term with enrichment, test prep, project-based learning, and Credly badges aligned to PA career standards.
- High school students explore careers through Drexel University; dual credit opportunities are also available with Harrisburg University.
- Pennwood partners with the Cook Center to offer 24-hour mental health support, student wellness curriculum, and staff professional development.
- Engagement Specialists work with families from day one to build strong connections and ensure success.
- Connections Academy schools are supported by Connections Education LLC, dba Pearson Virtual Schools, which is accredited by Cognia.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Pennwood Cyber Charter School operates on a semester system utilizing Carnegie units. One semester class equals one-half of a high school credit, and one credit equals approximately 180 hours of instruction. In addition to our school-specific graduation requirements, we adhere to the Pennsylvania Department of Education's Act 158, which requires students to fulfill various pathways focused on career and college readiness. Pennwood Cyber Charter School adheres to all state and national testing requirements and additionally encourages students to take the appropriate college entrance and preparatory exams necessary for reaching their personal and academic goals.

CAREER READINESS PROGRAM

Pennwood Cyber Charter School offers a robust college and career readiness program beginning in kindergarten, with early career exploration and C-Term projects in grades K–8. Students in grades 9–12 access traditional and career-focused courses, earning industry recognized credentials through partnerships with Coursera, Credly, The Home Depot, and more. Tools like, Coursera Career Prep, Smart Futures, and OSHA certification support individualized planning and evidence collection. Pennwood is launching an FBLA chapter, internships, and industry partners to promote real-world learning. Career Pathways in Business, IT, and Health Sciences prepare students for certifications and postsecondary success.
