OUR MISSION

The mission of South Carolina Bridge Connections Academy (SCBCA) is to provide a personalized education for students to master the knowledge and problem-solving skills needed to achieve their college and career goals.

OUR HISTORY

South Carolina Bridge Connections Academy was created with a clear purpose: to give students access to an educational experience designed around their individual goals, circumstances, and potential. Its foundation was built through a successful pilot initiative that showed how a focused academic model, personalized support, and greater flexibility could help students make meaningful progress. That proven approach led to the launch of South Carolina Bridge Connections Academy as an independent school beginning with the 2026-27 school year, strengthening its commitment to providing students with a purposeful path toward graduation and future success.

OUR PROGRAM

South Carolina Bridge Connections Academy is a fully virtual dropout prevention and recovery high school serving more than 400 students in grades 9-12. The school provides a complete diploma program designed to help students stay on track while navigating work, family responsibilities, and other life demands.

Students focus on four to five courses a semester using an adaptive online curriculum, which allows them to concentrate on mastering content and earning the credits needed to graduate. Most students complete approximately 10 courses per year and can earn up to 10.0 credits annually, or the credits remaining for graduation. The school operates 180 instructional days from August through June.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

South Carolina Bridge Connections Academy operates on a semester system utilizing Carnegie units. One semester class equals one high school credit, and one quarter class equals one half of a high school credit. Students who have taken high school courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit. The typical course load is 3.5 - 4.5 credits per semester.
